Thank you for trusting me with your travel plans. Before we begin designing your trip, I want to share how I work and what you can expect from our time together.

My role is to be your advocate from the first conversation through the moment you return home. That means hours spent researching destinations, vetting suppliers, comparing values, and building an itinerary that actually fits your desires and accessibility needs. The work happens long before you ever step on a plane, and it continues quietly behind the scenes once you do.

Specifically, I:

- Listen and understand your needs.
- Research itineraries and create personalized proposals based on those needs.
- Provide travel advice based on personal experience and years of training, particularly for those who are COVID-cautious, immunocompromised, have mobility issues, or have a chronic illness.
- Stay up to date on deadlines and requirements, reminding you via personalized emails and messages.
- Help you when things go wrong. I am on hold, so you don't have to be! I also have special contacts with companies that help me get things resolved much quicker than if you were to try and handle it on your own.
- Provide exclusive perks like free breakfast or cruise credit on some vacations, and real-time flight tracking.
- Organize group trips.

Planning + Process

CHECKLIST



- 1 You will meet with your travel advisor for a free consultation
- 2 You will sign the agreement form for the planning and booking fees, and input your credit card info to pay for the planning fee.
- 3 You will receive the initial proposal + itinerary, usually with 3-4 options.
- 4 You will provide feedback to the travel advisor on the itinerary and quotes.
- 5 You will provide your travel advisor with approval of the final Itinerary and travel insurance quote.
- 6 You will sign the travel services agreement and travel insurance waiver (if applicable), pay the trip deposit and travel insurance, and any booking fees (if applicable).
- 7 You will receive supplier invoices and confirmation of your payments. You will also have access to an app that shows your itinerary with real-time flight information.
- 8 If applicable, you will get dining, tours, spa, travel requirements, and payment reminders. You will also get travel tips.
- 9 You or your travel advisor will make final payments per agreed upon terms. Your travel advisor will be the contact person for any changes or issues (I stay on hold for you!).
- 10 You will review your final travel documents during your pre-departure call with your travel advisor (optional).

Fee Structure

To protect that level of care for every client, I charge a small set of professional service fees. These fees compensate me for my time and expertise, and they are separate from the cost of your travel. They are how I keep my attention on you rather than on whatever booking pays the most.

There is a flat \$47 research fee due directly after our free consultation. This is non-refundable. See our fee plans below. For more information, please review our **Service Fee Agreement Form**.

\$47 Research Fee

All itineraries will require a flat \$47 research fee due after the free consultation and before any itinerary is built. Booking a cruise or with one of our preferred suppliers will have no additional fee, other than the research fee.

Air

Booking airfare will incur a \$25 per person fee for domestic and a \$45 per person fee for international.

Groups 10+

Private groups of over ten people may require an additional, nominal flat fee. Group trips hosted by a travel agent may also require a fee in order to make up for travel costs.

Custom Itineraries

Some custom itineraries with bookings not a part of our preferred supplier's list will incur an additional fee. Customers will be notified of this nominal flat fee before booking. The final fee will depend on the complexity of the trip and is up to Accessible Escape LLC's discretion.
